## Landscape Committee Update

After reviewing the results of the survey, the Landscape Committee will focus their efforts on the perimeter of our subdivision on both 192nd and Pierce Street. This will include mulching of trees along Pierce, weed control and fertilization as well as mowing for both streets. Investigation has begun on an irrigation system for Pierce Street to maintain the trees and develop the grass areas. There will be quite a bit of work in the Spring replacing the dead trees along Pierce, cleaning of our Pacific Pointe sign and upgrading the plant material at our entrance at 192nd Street. Once construction is complete on Pacific, we will be evaluating additional enhancements for that section of our perimeter.
